Samuel was a member of the United States Army and served his country in WWII. After living in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, Samuel relocated to Flint, Michigan. He worked at General Motors for 36 years, retiring in 1982. Samuel later worked as a security guard to stay busy. He enjoyed spending time with his family, working in his yard and looking at cars. Samuel was a compassionate, giving, and loving man, who gave to others unconditionally. He was a past member of Mason Prince Hall Affiliation, as well as a member of Fairhaven Seventh-Day Adventist Church. On August 13, 1960, Samuel was united in Holy Matrimony to Doris Downey Scott.
