STEWART, Mr. Samuel III - Age 77, passed away Monday, February 18, 2008 at Covenant Health Care in Saginaw, MI. Family hour 10:30AM Monday, February 25, 2008 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, 719 E. Moore St., with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, G-5175 E. Bristol Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30AM Monday. Mr. Stewart will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-8PM Sunday. Mr. Samuel D. Stewart III was born June 12, 1930 in Marion, Alabama, the son of Samuel D. and Willie Mae Stewart II. Mr. Stewart retired from General Motors, and was a member of UAW Local #1292. After retirement, he began to drive buses for Valley Coach, Indiana Trail and Get Away. He was a Veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the Korean Conflict. Mr. Stewart graduated from Selma University High School and attended Xavier University in New Orleans, LA. He loved listening to Jazz and ballroom dancing.
