Mrs. Sandra E. Smith-Robbins was born on March 1, 1947 in St. Louis, Missouri, the daughter of Alexander and Evalyn Jones. At the age of 7, Sandra's Family relocated to Flint, Michigan. She graduated from Sacred Heart Catholic High School in 1965. She was hired by Fisher Body, a division of General Motors, at the age of 20. She remained a faithful employee at GM for 18 years until the Fisher Body location closed. During this time, she was blessed with one daughter, Deneshia Smith, who she loved dearly. After which, she became employed at Buick City until she retired in 1997. Sandra was so full of life; she had such a sweet spirit. She was always smiling and willing to help everyone. She was a mother to everyone and definitely had a house that everyone could call home. After retirement, Sandra spent most of her time travelling around the world. She never let grass grow under her feet. She was a devoted Christian and in 2000 joined Rock Missionary Baptist Church under

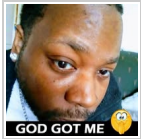
