Mr. Saundrell Lee "Sam" Baker was born July 25, 1947 in Muskegon, Michigan the son of Dottie M. Johnson and the late Andrew Baker. He attended Flint Community Schools, graduating from Flint Central High School, Class of '65. Sam was on the track team and excelled at Pole Vaulting. Sam was a member of Dozier Memorial CME Church, where he served as a Trustee and Usher. He was a long time Grand Blanc resident. Sam was employed with General Motors Truck & Bus, retiring in 2004 after 38 years of dedicated service. He was an avid bowler, enjoyed solving Saduko puzzles but he was a grill master. Sam specialized in anything that would fit on a grill. He was a fan of basketball and football. Sam was a die hard Michigan State Spartan. He always began his days studying Bible scriptures. Sam loved to stay informed on current events, catching the news on TV and reading the

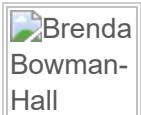
