Sheila joined Scotts Valley Methodist Church when she was about 10 or 11 years old. Sheila was one of the pioneers to integrate Lee Senior High School in Marianna, Arkansas. After finishing high school, she moved to Flint, Michigan where she united with Foss Avenue Missionary Baptist Church. Sheila also attended Mott Community College. Ms. Scott was a member of UAW Local #581, and worked at Fisher Body I a division of General Motors for 23 years, retiring on disability in 1995.
