Sherill Denise Harris went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, July 11, 2020. She was born on August 20, 1961 in Flint, Michigan the fourth daughter of Edward Everett Jr. and Marie Harris. Sherill loved the Lord and accepted Christ into her life at an early age. During her childhood in the Beecher District, she attended Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church. In California, Sherill was a faithful member and deaconess at Penial Church in El Sobrante, CA. At the time of her passing, Sherill was a member of Ebenezer Ministries in Burton, MI.

Sherill attended schools K – 12 in the Beecher School District: Messer Elementary, Summit Middle School and Beecher High School. She was an active member of the track team. Sherill was a Beecher High School graduate in the class of 1979. Following graduation, she moved to Lynwood in southern California. Later she moved to Richmond in northern California. In total, Sherill spent 35 years in California before returning to Flint in 2015.

Sherill worked in the restaurant industry most of her adult life. Before her

health began to fail, she was employed as a chef at Tina's Place in Pinole, CA. Sherill was a committed and loyal employee.

Sherill loved her family. She was passionate about spending time with them. She had a special relationship with each of her six siblings. Her family affectionately called her "Peewee". Sherill enjoyed listening to music; and until she lost her eyesight she was an avid Bible reader. She loved attending church, cooking; with pepper steak being her specialty, drawing, puzzles, and watching movies especially by Tyler Perry. 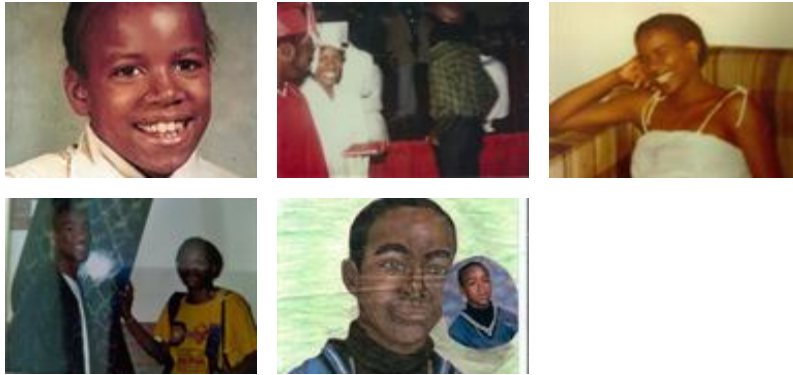

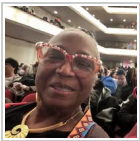
