Mrs. Sherry L. (Wisda) Jones was born May 31, 1954 in Sandusky, Michigan, to James and Shirley Wisda. Sherry displayed her talent and love for art and music at an early age. She graduated from Kearsley High School with honors in 1972, where she wrote a score for a high school musical. Sherry moved to Washington, DC by 1977 and established a lucrative musical career at the Capitol Hilton and performing for prominent members of DC society. In 1995, Sherry returned to Flint, Michigan with her daughter, Alicia J. Smith; to assist her father with his insurance business and his health. She also coordinated and performed at Tunes at Noon and taught special needs children teaching them how to read music. Sherry met Darrell A. Jones in 1997 and the two were married, January 1, 1999. She touched the heart of everyone she met; she was genuine, beautiful and full of life.

She leaves behind to cherish her memory: loving husband, Darrell Jones;

daughter, Alicia J. Smith; step daughter, Dominique Jones; mother, Shirley Wisda; brother, Jeff Wisda; a host of nieces, other relatives and great friends.
