Mrs. Green was raised in Flint and was a product of the Flint Community Schools, graduating from Central High School, "Class of 1950." After a brief stint in retail sales, Shirley was hired at A.C. Spark Plugs (Delphi) and retired in 1992. Shirley was a faithful and dedicated member of Christ the King Catholic Parish where she served in the Ladies Auxiliary of The Knights of St. Peter Claver Court 90.
