Mrs. Shirley Jean (Anderson) Hatten was born January 21, 1947 in Lundale, West Virginia as the fifth (5th) child to the union of the late Doriel and Earlene (Sanders) Anderson, Sr.

The family moved from West Virginia to Flint, MI in 1953 and Shirley attended Flint Public Schools. She was a former employee of Hurley Medical Center. She retired from the V8 Engine Plant, a division of General Motors. She was a former member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the Rev. R.R.
