Mrs. Shirleyan Gail Moss-Berry was born September 24, 1945 in Lake Charles, Louisiana, the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Lawrence and Ernestine Moss. She accepted Christ at a young age, being baptized at Woodberry Congregational Church. Shirleyan was the pianist and the organist for the Sunday School department. After graduating from W.O. Boston High School "Class of '64" in Lake Charles, LA she moved to Flint, Michigan with Lawrence III. In 1965, Shirleyan married William Cook. She was employed by State Farm Insurance Company as a Customer Service Agent. In 1980, Shirleyan met Jeddie C. Berry, the couple were married on July 4, 1980 under the bright lights of Las Vegas, Nevada. Shirleyan was a member of Vernon Chapel A.M.E. Church, under the leadership of Rev. Reuben Russell for several years. She attended Spring Arbor University, receiving her Bachelors. Upon her retirement from State Farm Insurance Company, Shirleyan decided to join Christ Episcopal, where she became a counselor at their Christ Enrichment

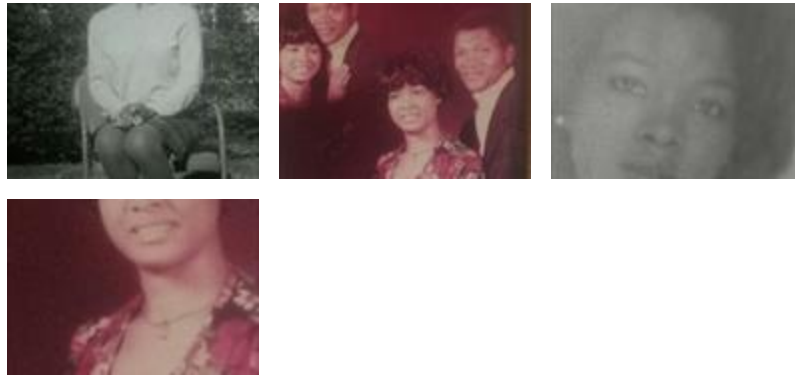

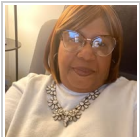
