Mr. Solomon relocated to Flint, where he met and married Billie Martin of Tennessee. He retired with 32 years of service from Buick, a division of General Motors Corporation, and was a member of UAW Local 599. Mr. Yearby was an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the United States Army, serving during the Korean Conflict. Solomon was a member of Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church, where he served as a Usher and sang with the Senior Male Choir. He loved to fish, hunt, and gardening.
