In 1969, the Mitts family relocated to Lansing, Michigan, where Sonji attended Lansing and Flint Community Schools. She graduated from Flint Central High School "Class of 1984". Sonji ran track and loved to dance. She also loved to go to church and hear the word of God. Sonji was affiliated with Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, Pastor Paul Garrett and Solid Rock Missionary Baptist Church, Pastor James Carter, in Lansing, Michigan. She visited numerous churches, but was currently a faithful member of Keys of the Kingdom Ministries under the leadership of Pastor Rosie Richardson. In 2005, she had a radio ministry on WFLT-1420 once a week. Sonji was a powerful dynamic speaker of prophecy and her favorite scripture was Psalms 91.
