BARNETT, Mr. Stanley O'Neal - Age 54, passed away Wednesday, July 15, 2009 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Friday, July 24, 2009 at Mt. Carmel Baptist Church, 1610 W. Flint Park Blvd, and may be viewed from 1PM-8PM Thursday. Mr. Stanley O'Neal Barnett was born January 11, 1955 in Laurel, Mississippi, the son of Charles and Bernice Barnett. Stanley was a resident of Flint. He accepted Christ at an early age and attended Galilean Baptist Church, under the Pastorate of the late Rev. Denzel Green. Stanley was a graduate of Flint Northwestern High School, "Class of 1973". He served in the United States Air Force, enlisting in 1974. His primary Specialty was Aerospace Ground Equipment Repairman. Stanley received an Honorable Discharge in 1976. He returned to Flint and began working for General Motors Corporation at the Fisherbody Turnstead-Flint Coldwater Road division, retiring after 18 years of service and was a member of UAW Local #326. Stanley enjoyed watching sports and was a "Die-hard" Detroit Pistons fan. He was kindhearted, thoughtful, and always remembering to call everyone on birthdays and holidays.
