TURNER, M.D., Stanley A - Age 73, of Flint, passed away Friday, September 8, 2006 at his residence surrounded by his loved ones. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12Noon- 8PM Thursday. Stanley A. Turner M.D. was born January 24, 1933 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Alex and Emmie Turner. Stan graduated from Northern High School and enrolled at Michigan State University and was the first black varsity baseball player. Stan signed a pro contract with the Cleveland Indians in 1954. He returned to Michigan State University to fulfill his dream of becoming a doctor after several career moves. Stanley graduated from the College of Human Medicine and specialized in Family Medicine. Dr. Turner held a solo private practice in Hartford, CT until retirement. Stan enjoyed reading and discussing the bible, woodworking, fishing and hunting. Stanley A. Turner M.D. leaves to cherish his memory: wife of 45 years, Rose Mary; daughter, Lisa Gaye Turner of Vernon, CT; son, Roman Stanley (Dinah) Turner of Fairview, CA; granddaughter, Jordan Simone Turner of Fairfield, CA; 2 sisters, Fannie Walker, Thelma (Thomas) Haywood and "play sister" James Ola Hill all of Flint; a host of nieces,
