(Sparrow) Battle was born February 2, 1945 in New Iberia, Louisiana, the daughter of Nicholas and Stella Sparrow the youngest of eight siblings was baptized at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Loreauville, LA. She graduated from Jonas Henderson High School in New Iberia, LA in 1963. After graduation, she lived in Houston, Texas, before moving to Flint, Michigan in 1967, later she was employed at AC Spark Plug. Stella married William L. Battle, March of 1968.
