JONES, Mr. Steven - Age 69, passed away Monday, May 11, 2026 at Hurley Medical Center in Flint, Michigan. A celebration of life will be held at a later date.

Steven Ronell Jones, 69, was born in Flint, Michigan, on February 26, 1957, to Rudolph Jones and Geraldine W. Smith. He was lovingly raised, guided, and deeply cherished by the man he proudly called father, Aaron A. Smith, whose unwavering love and presence helped shape the extraordinary man Steven became.

Steven was a proud product of the Flint Community Schools, attending Parkland Elementary School and Emerson Junior High School before graduating from Northern High School in 1975.

A gifted visionary in theater production and lighting design, Steven earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theater from Eastern Washington University and a Master of Fine Arts in Theater Management and Lighting Design from San Diego State University. He further honed his expertise in production and design as a proud member of IATSE Local 829.

Over the course of his remarkable career, Steven became a distinguished lighting designer and production director whose work left an indelible mark on

the entertainment industry. He spent 17 years as tour and production manager for Belafonte Enterprises, orchestrating national and international productions for

Harry Belafonte, including UNICEF events, global concerts, and television specials.

His expertise extended to major political events, including the 2000 Democratic

National Convention Presidential Gala and fundraiser, as well as lighting performances for legendary artists from Stevie Wonder to Barbra Streisand, and many more.

Steven later became an integral part of the Apollo Theater Foundation, serving as Lighting Director and Director of Production & Touring. Through his creativity, leadership, and commitment to excellence, he helped shape the world

of live entertainment for decades. In 2016, Steven founded Guided by Angels Productions, a reflection of both his artistic vision and generous spirit.

Through

consulting, speaking, and mentoring, he dedicated himself to inspiring and guiding the next generation of creatives, leaders, and dreamers.

In 1985, Steven married the love of his life, Kimberly Renee Edmonson, beginning a beautiful and devoted partnership that spanned 40 years.

Kimberly, a

talented dancer, fell in love not only with Steven's heart, but also with the brilliance of his artistic vision and lighting design. Their deep artistic connection,

two creatives united by a shared love for the arts, became the foundation of a remarkable life, enduring partnership, and loving family. Together they raised two

beloved daughters, Erin A. Jones and Alexandria Belle Jones, both of whom were

the pride and joy of Steven's life.

Steven was a deeply devoted husband, an adoring father, and a fiercely proud protector of his family. He found immense joy in supporting, encouraging, and celebrating those he loved, and there was nothing he would not do to uplift, protect, and provide for his wife and daughters.

Steven leaves to cherish his memory his beloved wife of 40 years, Kimberly Renee Jones of Detroit, Michigan; two daughters, Erin A. Jones of Harlem, New

York, and Alexandria Belle Jones of Mt. Vernon, New York; his mother, Geraldine

Smith of Flint, Michigan; his brother, Rev. Keith (Barbara) Jones of Spokane, Washington; his sister, Teri (Roy Jr.) Chambry of Burton, Michigan; and his uncle,

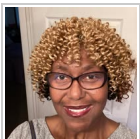
