GEORGE, Ms. Susie - Age 71, passed away Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at her residence. Susie Ann George, departed this earth and went home to her heavenly Father on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at her residence at the age of 71. Family hour 11:30 a.m. Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at Greater Galilee Baptist Church, 4418 Industrial Ave., with funeral service commencing at 12 p.m. Rev. Latrell Holmes Sr. officiating. She was the middle child born to Jim & Edlena Franklin.

Susie and her family relocated to Flint, Michigan in 1954 where she completed her education in the Beecher school district, graduating from Beecher High

School in 1961. Susie was the first black female basketball player at Beecher High School.

Susie was baptized at an early age at Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church in Bolivar, TN. Upon moving to Flint she united with St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor & Sister R. R. Gordon. Susie along with her family transitioned to Galilee Missionary Baptist Church, where she faithfully served under the leadership of Pastor & Sis. John T. Boyd by serving in the Choir; on the Mother's Board, Nurses Guild; as a Sunday School teacher, Vacation Bible School teacher; in the Mission and in her most important role as "Church Police". Susie was always known for taking gum, making you sit down and be quiet, and telling you your dress was too short or tight, no matter your age! Her faithful work continued through the transition into Greater Galilee Baptist Church, under the leadership of Pastor Latrelle W. Holmes Sr..

Susie was employed at Kmart and later General Motors where she retired in 1984. Susie later went to work as a receptionist at New Attitudes Beauty Salon & Fade King Barber Shop, quickly becoming "Aunt Sue" to all the stylists, barbers and customers. There Susie became an entrepreneur making and selling her legendary pound cakes for all to enjoy.

Susie enjoyed sewing. She sewed clothes, blankets and scarves. Her scarves became legendary and women all over Flint are seen wearing one of Susie's creations. Susie was also a church hat connoisseur; she wore hats in all colors, shapes and sizes.

Susie leaves to cherish her memory; four children, Troy Franklin of Logan, UT, Jeffrey (Angie) George, Cynthia George both of Flint and Heidi George of Dayton, OH; five grandchildren, Terrence George, Jasmine & Shalonda Granberry, Ajanti George & Ashley Brooks; four great-grandchildren, Alayja Granberry, Terryn & Amari George and Journei Carter-George; one brother, Jim (Patricia) Franklin of Davison, MI; two sisters, Emma (Theodore) Wiley & Cinda (Leon) Anderson; brother-in-law, William S.
