In 1928, she relocated to Detroit, MI and was a faithful member of the Springhill Missionary Baptist Church, where she served on the Usher Board. Susie was united in Holy Matrimony to Mr. Cleo Harris, who preceded her in death in 1949. Mrs. Harris was employed with Chrysler, a division of General Motors Corporation, until retiring in 1977. Due to illness, Susie relocated to Flint, where she could be in the care of relatives.
