In her sophomore year, she was crowned Queen—making history as the first African American Woman to receive that honor at her school. Her grace and leadership continued to shine as she was later named Miss Palladian Queen, a title that reflected both her beauty and her vibrant heart.

After graduation, Terrell began her career at General Motors. During this time,

she married Peathon Massey, and together they welcomed two children, September Gray and Sohn Massey. Following their divorce, Terrell later married James Bowers in 1970. Together, they built a successful career in sales with a cosmetics company, where Terrell's passion and people skills helped her rise to the position of National Sales Director. Her success allowed her to travel widely, forming countless cherished friendships and lifelong connections along the way.

After years of adventure and accomplishment, Terrell and James made their home in Atlanta, Georgia. It was there that Terrell dedicated her life to God and found joy in serving her church and community. Known for her generosity and warm hospitality, she loved hosting dinner parties, decorating, attending estate sales, and watching the History Channel. She was also a gifted cook and a devoted prayer warrior—always ready with an encouraging word and a heartfelt prayer for anyone in need.

After her separation from James Bowers, Terrell returned home to Michigan to lovingly care for her mother. During this time, she became a devoted member of Faith Tabernacle, where she found a beautiful community of family and friends who supported her as she rebuilt her life.

Following her mother's passing, Terrell continued to live a life of service and compassion. She cared tenderly for her beloved Aunt Bernice Seay until the Lord called her home, and she found great joy and purpose in raising her grandson.

Terrell's heart for others was evident in everything she did. She never hesitated to open her home or share what she had with those in need. Whether she was feeding the hungry or offering words of encouragement, Terrell nourished both body and soul—sharing not only food, but also the Word of God. Her kindness, generosity, and faith touched countless lives,
