ANDERSON, Ms. Terry (Brandon) - Age 61, went home to be with the Lord, Sunday, August 11, 2013 at Hurley Medical Center. Terry worked for the Flint Community Schools in her younger years as a Paraprofessional at Dort Elementary School.
