Jackson graduated from Flint Central High School and attended Flint Community College. He was a resident of Flint his entire life and confessed Christ at an early age. Bro. Jackson was united in holy matrimony on February 24, 1961 to Ella Louise. They celebrated 48 years of marriage. To this union five children were born. Brother Jackson was employed as a Sales Agent for North Carolina Mutual and Allstate for over 20 years. He retired from AAA after 9 years in 2005. Bro. Jackson was a member of Mt.
