PEARSON, Mr. Thomas Coleman, Jr. - Age 61, passed away Sunday, June 22, 2008 at Hurley Medical Center after a short illness. Family hour 10AM Saturday, June 28, 2008 at Vermont Christian Church, 1201 Lippincott Blvd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM. Pastor Jonathan Graves officiating. Pearson and the late Carrie L. (Napier) Pearson. Thomas was the youngest of three and the only son. He graduated from Melvin High School in 1963 and moved to Flint, Michigan in August 1964. He later moved to Manhattan, New York and worked for Verizon Communications for 25 years as a telecommunications splicer and service repair man.
