Mr. Thomas Elbert Rosborough was born November 24, 1924 in Texarkana, Arkansas the second of three sons born to Primes Rosborough and Georgia (Bead) Rosborough-Taylor. He was educated in the Flint Public School System and graduated from Flint Northern High School. After graduating, Thomas was Honorably Discharged from the United States Army having served in WWII. He retired from Buick Motor Company, a division of General Motors, with over 40 years of employment. On July 20, 1947 Thomas married the love of his life, Betty Jane Reed. On July 20, 2007, the couple celebrated 60 years of marriage. With his best friend and soul-mate, Betty, the couple loved to travel and attend plays. They enjoyed their time together until her death on May 8, 2008. Thomas was an avid and accomplished bowler who was well known in the bowling circuit around town. He was seen frequently in the local bowling alleys, where he bowled on many different leagues. Thomas

was a long time, devoted and faithful member of Bethel United Methodist Church. He was very active in all aspects of the church.
