Thomas "Tony" Saines was born September 4, 1951 in Bolivar, Tennessee as the fifth child of William and Alice Saines. He confessed Christ at an early age at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church and later united with Greater Galilee Baptist Church. Thomas loved to work in the kitchen, cooking breakfast and serving others. Tony graduated from Northwestern High School in 1969. Thomas served his country as a member of the U.S. Army, enlisting January 26, 1971 and was honorably discharged December 16, 1972. Tony had one daughter, Sabrina Williams, born March 28, 1969, who departed this life on April 5, 1999.
