BURNS, Mrs. Tomisha - Age 37, passed away Thursday, September 23, 2010 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, October 2, 2010 at First Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, 1226 Beach St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m., Pastor F.O. Hockenhull officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Mrs. Burns will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Friday, with family present from 5-8 p.m. Mrs. Tomisha Latoya (Mixon) Burns was born in Flint, Michigan on June 17, 1973. "The ONLY" child of Rosemary Mixon and Joseph Jones, Jr. Tomisha was a member of First Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, where she learned the true value of prayer. She graduated from Flint Central High School, "Class of 1991." Tomisha was employed at Taco Bell, Inc., for 15 years where she worked her way up to become Assistant Manager, before her health began to decline. She was a sweet and kind person, who had such a giving spirit and who dearly loved spending time with her children and families (Mixons, Joneses and Burns). Tomisha was the very model of class and good taste. In her final months, she spoke of a strong desire to be formally educated in the medical field, hoping to one day return to the workforce.
