“ Tommie was a very good friend of mine. We first met in the fall of 1968 at Ferris State University playing football for the Bulldogs. Our team recorded the first undefeated football season in Ferris State’s history and was recently inducted into the Ferris State University Athletic Hall of Fame. Tommie was our leading rusher and scored the most touchdowns that year. As a result, at the end of the season he was named to the small college All-American team! In the spring of 1969, on our way home to Flint after a spring football practice we miraculously survived a terrible rollover car accident. After that the bond between us became even stronger. Several years ago I was asked to read a congratulatory letter from our FSU Coach, Bob Leach, when Tommie was inducted into the Greater Flint African-American Hall of Fame. At the ceremony, as I stood on the stage with him, he told the audience that I was a like brother to him! Needless to say, that brought tears to my eyes. Brother Tommie, you will be forever missed but never forgotten! Rest In Peace!
