Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Wednesday. She was born April 22, 1932 in England, Arkansas to Johnnie Dedrick Sr. and Sophronia Alexander-Dedrick. Travlee attended Gartrell High School in Arkansas and later received her high school diploma from Flint Central High School after moving to Flint, Michigan. Travlee married Andrew Ollings September 22, 1950, and to this union was born her only daughter Muriel Ester Ollings-Conner. Mrs. Van Buren later met and married O.D. Van Buren in 1968. Travlee belonged to the Flint Chapter of the Eastern Stars and she retired from General Motors in 1997 after 28 years of service. After her retirement, she devoted the rest of her life to being a loyal member of Faith Baptist Temple, where Freelon Threlkeld is the Pastor, and a loving mother, sister, aunt, grandmother and great grandmother.
