Kelly, Mr. Tyrone G. "Tee" - age 74, passed away Thursday, July 10, 2014 at Hurley Medical Center. Mr. Kelly will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 12 p.m.-8 p.m. Wednesday. Mr. Kelly was Honorably Discharged from the U.S. Air Force.

Mr. Tyrone Gene "Tee" Kelly was born April 8, 1940 in Bartow, Jefferson County, Georgia, the son of Thomas Kelly and Emma Z. Turner. As a young boy his family moved to Chicago and eventually to Flint, Michigan with his stepfather, Johnnie B. Dothard. Tyrone attended Clark Elementary, Whittier Junior High and Flint Central High graduating in 1959. On December 2, 1959, He entered the US Air Force serving until November 29, 1963. After military service, Tyrone attended Flint Junior College (Mott Community College) and University of Michigan-Flint, where he received his Bachelors in General Studies. He worked for GM-Flint V8 Engine as Supervisor. In 1989, he returned to his first love, electronics, graduating from Devry Institute of Technology in Chicago, Illinois. Tyrone attended Holbrook Ave Church of God, 12th Street Church of God and New Creation Church of God until his illness.

He enjoyed singing and joined different choirs within the church. Tyrone enjoyed sports especially, bowling, basketball, roller skiing with the Lyons family, listening to Johnny Mathis, watching Tiger Woods golf, fixing and tinkering with anything. He loved ice-cream.
