The daughter of Alfonso and Estella Johnson. She was united in marriage to Matt (Zeke) Tolbert, May 31, 1947. Venola retired from teaching in the Flint Community School System in 1993 after 24 years of service. She was a devoted member of Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle and an active member of the Nurse's Guild. Venola enjoyed fishing, the outdoors, and was a regular walker at Courtland Center Mall. She was also an avid movie goer and active in UAW 599 Retiree Chapter.
