Flint Park Blvd. Viewing will be from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Friday with family present from 5-8 p.m. Mr. Victor Gonzalez was born May 21, 1939 in Carolina, Puerto Rico, the beloved son of Ernesto Gonzalez and Laura Esquilin. Victor graduated from Flint Central High School in 1957, going on to attend Mott Community College before beginning his 44 year career with General Motors Truck and Bus, retiring at the age of 68. He was a proud member of UAW Local 598. While at General Motors, his future brother-in-law, Leroy Collins II, introduced him to Margaret Phinisee. During their courtship, he came to know Jesus Christ as his personal savior and committed himself to membership at the Church of God, Flint, MI, under the leadership of the late Pastor Roy Bibbs, Jr. Victor soon married Margaret on June 26, 1982. He enjoyed fishing, and being the life of the party among his family and friends. His infectious laugh will always be remembered. Victor has become lovingly known as "The Puerto Rican Deacon" at Ambassador's for sharing his faith by leading Bible studies there after his recent rededication of his life to the Lord.
