Mr. Victor Watson, Jr., was born August 8, 1929 in Wisner, Louisiana, the son of Mr. Victor Sr., and Mrs. Frances (Ferguson) Watson. Mr. Watson confessed his faith in God at an early age and was a member of the New Light Baptist Church in Wisner, Louisiana. He also received his education in the Louisiana Public School System. Mr. Watson married the "Love of his Life", Mary Lene Swazer on January 21, 1950. To this union, one (1) son, Alvin Lawrence was born. He was a Self-Employed Builder/Carpenter for over fifty (50) years. The Watsons opened their hearts and their home to many including nieces, Dr. Frances Conley and Ms. Veola Sargent. They also reared as their own, their grandson, Prentiss Roshawn Rollins, and cousin, Pasquell Delano Brown. They also had a loving parent-son relationship with Edward Minor, just to name a few. Mr. and Mrs. Watson relocated to Flint, Michigan in 2006 because of their failing health, and to be with their son who served as their primary care-taker for the duration of both of their lives.
