Mr. Victor George Young, Jr. was born August 28, 1941 in Harlem, NY, The son of Victor George Young Sr. and Sarah Newton Young. He lived in Harlem until he graduated from East Harlem High School in 1959. In 1960, he moved to Indiana where he worked in a factory until he later moved to Flint, MI in 1967.

He then began working in the Foundry for Buick Motor Company in 1967 where he worked for many years until he began working as a laborer for the Coca Cola Company. In 1977 he began doing one of the things he loved, driving a bus for the Flint City Schools. His final job before retiring was driving a bus for the Saginaw Transit Authority.

In January 1976 he met and fell in love with Anelia Mcneil; they later married on August 29, 1987. He was a loving and selfless man, who never complained

as the primary caregiver of his wife and soul-mate for many years.
