EVANS, Mr. Vincent Lamont - Age 50, went home to be with Lord, Friday, February 1, 2013 at University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, MI. Memorial Service 11 a.m. Saturday, February 9, 2013 at Ebenezer Ministries, 2130 S. Center Rd. Bishop Urundi Knox, Host Pastor. Family and friends will assemble at the church 11 a.m. Saturday. There will be no public viewing.

Mr. Vincent L. Evans was born June 14, 1962 in Flint, Michigan to the late John R. Evans and Julia M. (Cyrus) Evans. He accepted the Lord as his Savior as a young man and was baptized at Ebenezer Baptist Church, under the leadership of the late Pastor Clarence Knox. Vincent served in the capacity of Deacon-in-Training at Ebenezer Ministries under the leadership of Bishop Urundi Knox until his death.

Vincent was a kind, compassionate young man, who loved God, his family, his church and his many friends. He loved all types of sports with football being his favorite. Vincent attended Michigan Tech University in Houghton, MI and Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, MI, where he played football. He coached football at Beecher High School and Ferris State University. Vincent was a wonderful son, father, brother, cousin, and friend who will be sorely missed, but never forgotten.
