Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Wednesday. Mr. Vincent LaVon Pounds, Sr. was born May 14, 1951 in Flint, Michigan, the son of James and Beulah Pounds. Vincent accepted Christ at an early age and was a lifelong member of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. He was employed by General Motors Grand Blanc for 17 years before retiring and was a member of UAW Local 1292. For the past six years, Mr. Pounds volunteered with Safe Passage RSVP and was stationed at Carpenter Road Elementary School as a Crossing Guard; many of the Carpenter Rd. students referred to him as "granddad", they knew he would be there to get them safely to school every morning and would come back in the afternoon to see them home safely. He loved to walk at Bluebell Beach every morning; spending time with nature and talking to the Park Rangers, as well as other morning hikers. Vincent enjoyed having a backyard garden and sitting in his backyard, but most of all spending time with his family really filled his heart. Mr. Vincent L.
