Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 1:00 p.m-8:00 p.m. Friday. Ms. Wanda Stinnett "Kaye" was born in March 31, 1957 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Cleveland and Mary Lee Stinnett. She grew up in Flint and graduated from Northwestern High School in 1975. Wanda also graduated from Baker College and attended Pilgrim Temple Church Of God In Christ (now Jackson Memorial Temple Church Of God In Christ) where she sang in the Mass Choir and the District Choir. On July 24, 2012 she accepted Christ as her Personal Savior under the guidance of Elder George Coulter. Wanda was a fix-it woman who could repair or make just about anything. Her brothers affectionately referred to her as "My Brother Kaye." Wanda was a very comical person especially at all family gatherings. She was a free spirit; she loved to cook and create new recipes. Wanda was trivia savvy and was knowledgeable on most subjects. She really loved music. When she spoke you knew exactly what she meant and how she felt.
