BUTLER, Mr. Wardell - Age 95, passed away Saturday, January 10, 2015 at McLaren-Flint. Family hour 10 a.m. Friday, January 16, 2015 at Pentecostal Temple C.O.G.I.C., 2320 Caniff St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Friday. Mr. Butler will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1-8 p.m. Thursday. Mr. Wardell Butler was born July 7, 1919 in Memphis, Tennessee, the son of David Butler and Mary Harris. His parents moved to Michigan in 1921. Wardell was raised in Flint, Michigan, he married Esteena "Tee" Gray September 19, 1945, after only knowing her for three weeks, "Love at 1st sight!" He retired from Chevrolet, a division of General Motors in 1975 with over 30 years of service. Wardell loved building and repairing things around the house the house and the cottage up North, but most of all he was an avid fisherman. He was 95 years young with a strong love for his "Soulmate" of over 69 years. So strong was the love story that he followed his wife "Tee" home to glory after only 48 days.
