GREEN, Mr. Wence - Age 69, passed away Sunday, June 22, 2008 at Hurley Medical Center. Family Hour 11AM Monday, June 30, 2008 at House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church, 1851 W. Mr. Wence Gregory "Green" Green was born December 18, 1938 in Heth, Arkansas, the son of Frances and Wence "Red Diamond" Green. "Green" was raised in West Memphis, Arkansas, where he was known throughout as an All-Star Athlete. In 1956 he earned a football scholarship to Mississippi Industrial College (MS). In 1957 he was called by the St. Louis Cardinal "Bomb Team" but chose to stay in school. He later served in the military. In 1964 he relocated to Flint, MI, four years later in 1968, he met his devoted loving wife of 40 years. He also attended Pine Bluff AM & N College during this time. Wence worked at Hurley Medical Center and AC Spark Plug. His love was golfing, fishing, cooking and playing dominoes. However, his pride and joy was his wife, children, and grandchildren. Nothing was more important than family.
