Mr. Wilbert Leander Green was born on June 28, 1928 in Greenville, North Carolina, the son of Johnnie and Thelma (Jenkins) Green. "Daddy Green" was a longtime member of Ceda Grove Baptist Church. He relocated to Flint at the age of 27. Mr. Green was an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the United States Army serving during the Korean Conflict. He was the proud father of five children by his former wife, Willie Mae Green. In 1972, "Daddy Green" was united in Holy Matrimony to Rayphelia Williams. Retiring after devoting 36years of service to Truck & Bus, a division of General Motors Corporation, and was a member of UAW Local 598. "Daddy Green" was the founder of the Recovery Club that was affiliated with Alcoholics Anonymous. He was also the director of the Freedom Train Program.
