Mr. William Lee "Little Bill" Hill was born December 30, 1930 in Mounds, Illinois, to Ida Mae Hill. William lived in Mounds during his childhood, completing his schooling approximately through the sixth grade. In his later childhood he migrated north of Holly, Michigan, where he was taken in by Mrs. Loma Turner "Aunt Loma", who was his caregiver until he moved on to Flint. He married Margaret Jones (preceded him in death in 1961); there were three children in this marriage: Sue A. Hill, Rochelle L. Hill and William E. Hill, all of Flint, Michigan. Mr. Hill was employed at Chevrolet Manufacturing, a division of General Motors in 1950, and retired in 1980 with 30 years of service. He was a very good worker and a good father to his children.
