MARSHALL, Mr. William "Bill" Thomas - Age 84, passed away Tuesday, December 17, 2013 at Gentiva Hospice-Flint. Family hour 10 a.m. Friday, December 27, 2013 at Morningstar Missionary Baptist Church, 2120 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Keith J. Bigelow, Sr. officiating. Mr. William Thomas Marshall a.k.a. "Bill" was born in Memphis Tennessee on January 27, 1929. He served in the Korean War and was Honorably Discharged. Bill then relocated to Flint Michigan in 1952, which is where he made his permanent residence. He was a faithful member of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church and attended for over fifty years. While a member, he served in several capacities; he was a member of the National Baptist Laymen's Convention, Board of Trustee, Usher Board and Sunday School Superintendent, Choir Director and member of the Male Chorus, and faithfully performed his duties as van driver long after it was expected. "Bill" retired from Fisher Body Plant I, a division of General Motors as a Crane Operator after thirty years of service. He was a gifted singer and musician, loved playing pool, checkers and participating in the Old Ship of Zion productions. He also

loved to sing, enjoyed great meals and delighted in shopping.
