Our beloved Father, brother, uncle, nephew and cousin, Willie James Cobb, Jr. was born November 24, 1949 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Willie James, Sr. and Clara Mae Cobb. Willie of "Mann" as he was affectionately known to by family and many friends. Willie was a beloved father of 2 daughters. He graduated from Flint Northwestern High School, "Class of 1967" where he was Captain of the Wrestling team and achieved the honor of the school's first State Wrestling Championship. Willie also attended Grand Rapids Community College and later received his Bachelor's Degree from the University of Michigan-Flint. He retired from Chevy/Delphi of Flint, a division of General motors where he enjoyed working alongside many of his friends and neighbors. "Mann" was well known for his love of family, music and friends. When asked about the funny stories remembered, his cousins readily shared the pleasure he took in teasing them, dancing with them and laughing as they called him "Blue Cobb". Mr. Cobb

Pisgah Missionary Baptist Church and on occasion at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church.
