Willie served in the United States Army as Staff Sargent from 1970-1977, Self Study and toured Europe from 1977-1979, Policeman with Washington DC Police Department from 1980-1984. He served with The Old Guard where his unit escorted the President of the United States and provided security for Washington, DC in times of National Emergency or Civil Disturbance. Willie was awarded the United States Air Medal for the period of June 7, 1970 to November 30, 1970 and the Bronze Star Medal for the period of June 1970 to April 1971. He retired as a Car Salesman for Randy Wise-Chevrolet.
