Willie retired from Chevrolet Metal Fabricating, a division of General Motors and was a member of UAW Local 659. He loved all music, with jazz being his favorite and he knew the history of jazz well. Willie enjoyed composing music and would often write songs for his children. Some of his favorite musicians and singers were, John Coltrane, Pharaoh Sanders, Horace Silver, Miles Davis and Sara Vaughan. Willie played the saxophone, piano and organ with "My Funny Valentine", Moon Rivers" and "Mr. Magic", being his favorite songs to play. He also enjoyed swimming, exercising at the health spa, traveling, reading and attending jazz festivals. Willie often flew to California to attend all the major concerts and was looking forward to attending two more in Canada and Switzerland. He was always smiling and loved just relaxing, talking to his children, family and friends, going to the movies, church,

listening to gospel music, and bowling, which he was voted the most improved bowler in his league. One of his most recent hobbies was learning Spanish. Since he retired he especially enjoyed spending time with his sister, brother-in-law and their great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
