Mrs. Willie Mae Green, the daughter of Will Arthur Streeter and Louise Williams was born March 3, 1933 in Farmville, North Carolina. There she was an active member of Moye Chapel until relocating to Michigan with her husband, Wilbert Leander Green in 1954. Before becoming a full-time homemaker, she worked at the Voyager Inn as a Housekeeping Supervisor for over 20 years. Mrs. Green gave birth to 7 children and raised an additional 5 including her sister, Mary Louise Wilson, grandsons, Ken Arthur, Levonne and Gevonne Green and nephew, Rodney (Latresa) Wilson. She was also a surrogate mother to many including Lee Bohnett and Tinekka (Gregory) Clemons. "Mae" enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren, traveling, cooking, dancing, reading the Bible and praising the Lord.
