ROGERS, Mr. Wilson - Age 61, passed away Thursday, May 21, 2009 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10:30AM Friday, May 29, 2009 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Mr. Wilson "Sonny" Rogers was born December 5, 1947 in Evergreen, Alabama, the son of the late Wilson Moore and Cornelia Rogers. Wilson was a true Christian. He had a heart of compassion, love and caring for all. Wilson joined St. Paul United Methodist Church in Evergreen, Alabama at an early age and continued to attend until he was called to serve his country. He graduated from Conecuh County High School as well as the County Trade School with an Associate Degree in Electronics. Mr. Rogers served his country in the United States Army from 1969 until 1970, during the Vietnam War. After returning home in 1971, he moved to Flint, Michigan, where he was employed with General Motors for 30 years. Mr. Rogers loved his family very much.
