McCLINTON, Mr. Winston V. - Age 56, passed away Wednesday, January 12, 2011 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 12Noon Saturday, January 22, 2011 at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, 2115 W. Coldwater Rd., with funeral service commencing at 1 p.m. Pastor Michael Pettigrew officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 12Noon Saturday. Mr. McClinton will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8 p.m. Friday. Mr. Winston Venoy McClinton was born March 26, 1954 in Marianna, Arkansas to the union of Bertran and Willie Mae McClinton. Winston accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church for more than 50 years. He faithfully sang in the Male Chorus and served as St. Paul's "Chief of Security." Winston attended Flint Community Schools, graduating in 1972 from Northwestern High School.
