Wyretha graduated from Kiblah High School and attended Arkansas State University in Pine Bluff (UAPB). She also attended Mott Community College where she obtained her Associates degree in Nursing. Wyretha moved to Flint, Michigan with her husband Charles and was gainfully employed at Kith Haven, Flint Osteopathic Hospital, later retiring from Hurley Medical Center in 2001. At an early age, Wyretha joined and was baptized at St. Matthew Missionary Baptist Church in Bradley, Arkansas.
