She received her high school diploma in 1954. After completion of high school, Yvonne moved to St. Louis, MO where she met and married Earnest Lee Nealy in 1956. They later moved to Flint, Michigan and were together for 23 years. Yvonne was employed at Yankee Department Store for a number of years. After leaving Yankee Department Store, Yvonne obtained employment with Chevrolet Manufacturing (also known as “The Hole”), a division of General Motors Corporation where she retired in 1999. Yvonne accepted Christ at an early age and was very active in church as a member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church on Hickory Street. She was the first president of the Voices of Macedonia Choir and she continued to serve the Lord in various capacities and churches throughout her life. Yvonne enjoyed

music and traveling. Her favorite music was gospel, and anything by Luther Vandross. While in memory care, she would frequently tell her sister, Bernice that the late Voices member, Al Malone, was the singer in each gospel song that she heard. She never forgot about her choir. One of Yvonne's favorite hobbies was bowling. Yvonne and Earnest created their own bowling team in Flint and competed for many years. Yvonne enjoyed traveling to various places with her family.
