She attended Mott Community College and Baker College, where she majored in accounting. Upon the death of her mother, Mrs. Charlie Mae Walker on November 17, 1967, Yvonne took on the responsibility for raising her five younger siblings. Four of her siblings, along with all of her children earned college degrees. Two of her brothers served in the U.S. Marine Corps.
