CARTER, Mrs. Zenobia - Age 68, passed away Friday, July 13, 2007 at her residence. Family hour 11AM Wednesday, July 18, 2007 at Christ Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church, 317 E. Hamilton Ave., with funeral service commencing at 12Noon. Dr. Jeffery P. Kee officiating. Dr. Leroy Shelton, Host Pastor. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Wednesday. Mrs. Carter will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Tuesday. Mrs. Zenobia Delores Carter was born December 13, 1938 in Memphis, Tennessee, the daughter of Hobart and Katherine Johnson. Zenobia accepted Christ at an early age and reared her children in the word of God. She was a very meticulous person and devoted to the community. Zenobia was also a self-defined poet. She started her career with Chase (formerly Genesee Bank) in 1964 as a clerk in the loan department. She was Genesee Bank's first African American female branch Manager after a succession of promotions. Zenobia retired in 2001 from Bank One as a Vice President in the Human Resource Department. She also attended Mott Community College. She enjoyed writing poetry, crafts, gardening and cooking. Zenobia also loved spending time with her grand and great-grandchildren. Mrs. Zenobia Delores Carter leaves to cherish her memory: 4 daughters, Brenda (Alfred) Jacobs of Lancaster, TX, Phyllis Carter of Flint, Sharon (Elbert) Hicks of Grand Blanc, and Beverly Lawler of Lilburn, GA; son, Claude Carter of Flint; special son-in-law, Raynard Lawler; 15
